Optional items not included in the supply kit: dictionary, tote bag (backpacks are not allowed in the classrooms). Also keep in mind that some items (pencils and paper, for example) will need to be replenished throughout the school year.

Each student needs a method of organizing materials (returned papers, worksheets, etc). Some choices include:

1. Organize by color. Designate a different color notebook and/or folder for each class.
2. Organize subjects using a zipper expanding file. (\*Please note: Many of these do not fit inside lockers, and the students will be responsible for carrying them all day. They have nowhere to leave them during the school day, since all classrooms are being utilized at different times.\*)
3. Organize using a large (2" or 3") 3-ring binder with dividers.
