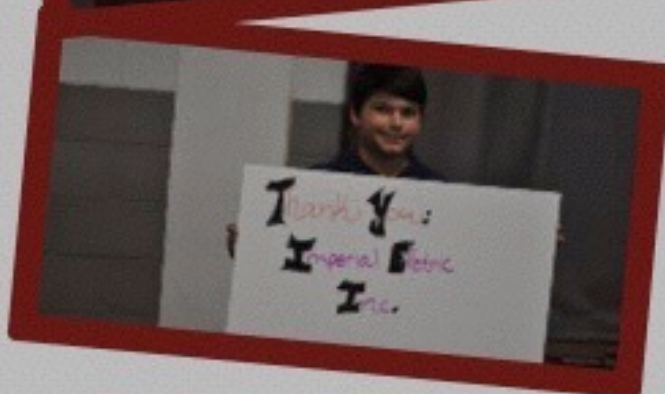
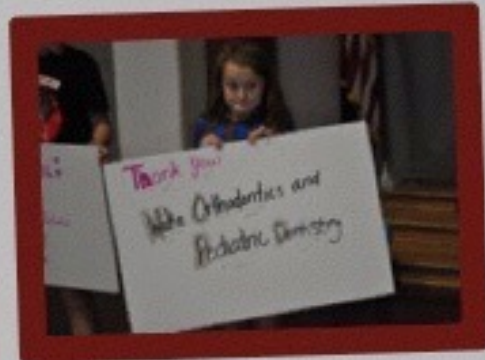

### There is still time to sign up

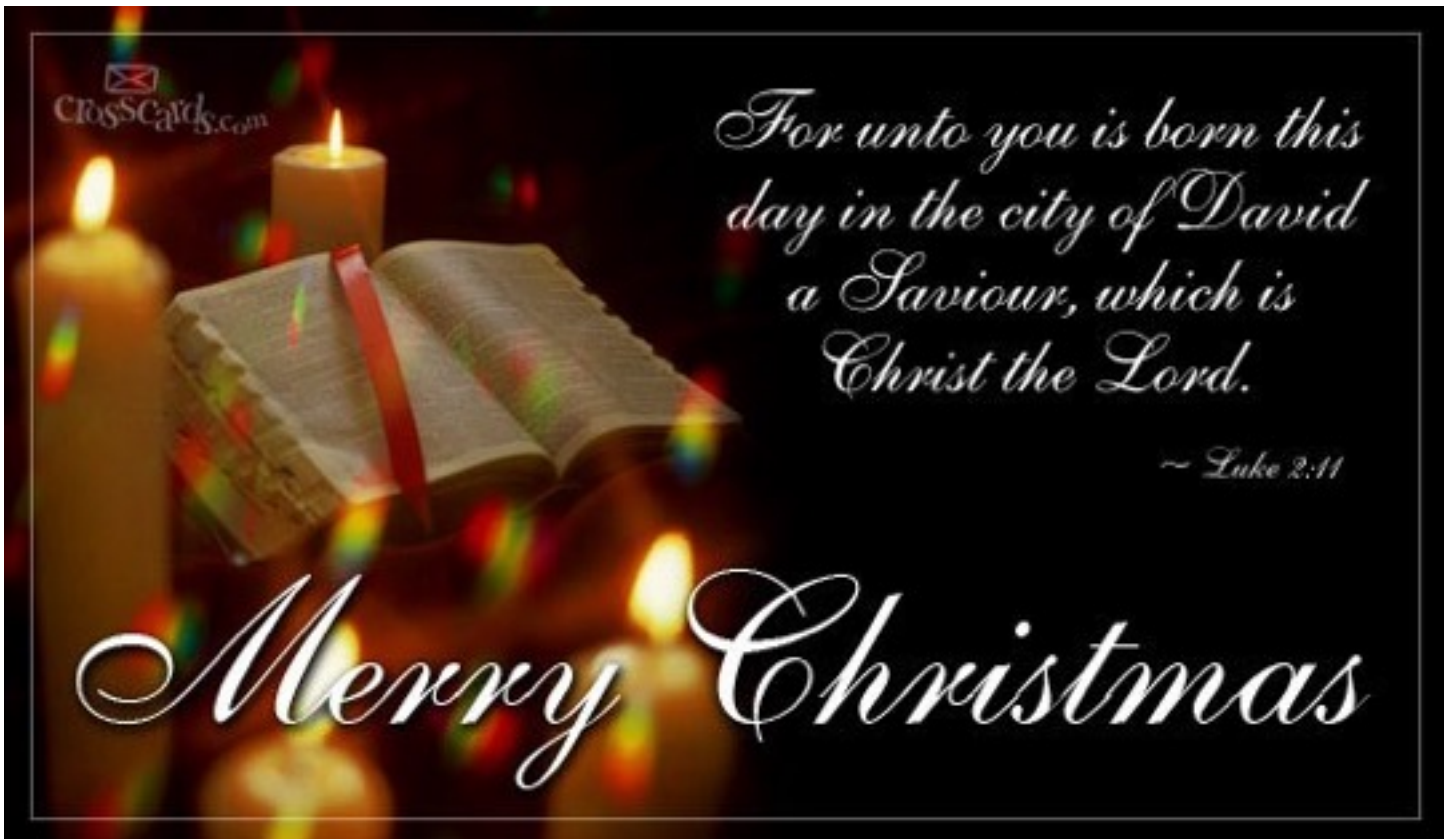
