Fence in the Cafeteria Patio – The cafeteria patio is a perfect spot for our school children to enjoy North Carolina's lovely weather during their lunch period. Fencing in this area will make it more secure. Additionally, it will serve as another safe area for aftercare children to play.

OPERATION SHOWER PACKS is a new school-wide service project that StMM will be participating in during the week of January 30th thru February 3rd. This program was started by the Holly Springs non-profit organization Military Missions in Action ("MMA"); a 501c3 company that supports North Carolina veterans, active duty, disabled, homeless and their dependent families. MMA helps veterans achieve independent living in numerous ways as well as assisting active duty service men and women deployed in combat situations and their families here at home.

The Shower Packs program may seem simple, but is very impactful. Ziplock bags full of hygiene items are handed out to veterans hospitals, homeless shelters, shower facilities overseas as well as local bases here in NC. Please take a moment to check out the efforts of the organization
